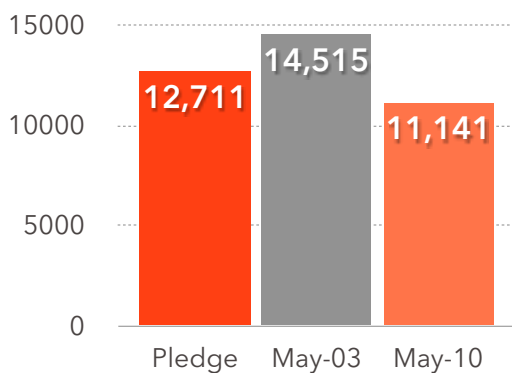

Volunteer Needs

Below are the descriptions of the different volunteer needs. Please register to volunteer here.

General Volunteer - Willing to serve; open to any activity. You will be contacted with as much advance notice as possible.

Rapid Responder - Able to serve without any advance notice and available for urgent needs.

Trauma Informed Care - Willing to be trained (typically a one day workshop) in trauma informed care. Will be trained to respond appropriately to needs in traumatic situations. If you are a social worker, you may already have this training.

Arts and Education - Educated in arts education (visual or performing) or in an education discipline and are able and willing to teach a class (up to 1 hour) in your respective discipline (i.e. Saturday Academy setting) of 4 to 6 months at a time.

Mentor - individuals with the time and patience for on going mentoring of a preteen or teenage youth. A background check and some training is required. Men are especially needed.

We ask for your continued prayers as our HOPE worldwide chapter representatives work to engage community organizers and find ways we can serve and support the healing and restoration of this great city. Our belief is that God has called us to be peace makers and that he will lead us as he has done before to do his will in the midst of the most challenging times.
